How to Talk about God - Be Perfect?!

Hi,

I asked John if he had ever shared the gospel with our friend, Mike. His reply:

"Oh, yeah, like I'm a shining example of a Christian."

It caught me off guard. What do you think?

Do we need to be the "perfect" Christian in order to tell someone else about Jesus?

I thought of the Pharisees. They WERE the morally shining example. They followed God's commands fully. At the temple every Sabbath.

Even made up some of their own rules, just to be extra, squeaky clean.

Yet, Jesus called them blind guides. He said when the Pharisees made a convert, they made them "twice the child of hell" as themselves (twice as evil - Matthew 23:15).

Then I thought of the woman at the well (in John 4). She was almost the polar opposite. She was married five times and currently living with a sixth guy. Though her lifestyle hadn't changed at all yet, she led her entire town to believe in Jesus.

What's the difference?

She knew who Jesus was. The Pharisees didn't.

She didn't know a lot about Jesus, but she knew enough. She knew who he was. And she told others, because she wanted them to know him also.

Do you want others to know Jesus?

Here's an easy way to tell them something about God. I prepared for you a five-minute video that explains how to have a very short conversation with someone about God...less than a minute conversation.

How to Talk about God - Sharing the Gospel

Hi,

What if someone asked you how they could know God? What would you tell them?

Someone actually asked me once.

I will never forget how utterly stumped I was. I was getting back to my dorm, maybe 2 a.m., when a good friend named Cindy met me in the hallway. And with real intensity she said:

"I've been looking for you all night. Where have you been?! I want to become a Christian. What do I do?"

Given who this was, I was shocked. Then I realized that I had no idea what to tell her.

I had become a Christian only a few months earlier. I knew that I simply asked Jesus into my life. So, I reasoned, *"Well, I think we should pray."*

So with her, I prayed out loud, asking Jesus to come into her life.

It was the best I could think of.

Three years later, a sorority sister, Brittany, had a particularly bad episode with the drug, LSD.

The next morning Brittany said to me, *"I want to become a Christian."*

By this time I had learned how to explain the gospel to someone, with Scripture. (That's what I'm about to show you. I'm going to give you what I covered with her.)

After going through this information with her, I then asked her, *"Would you like to invite Jesus into your life?"*

She answered with a question - *"Will I have to read the Bible?"*

I said, *"Well, no. You can receive Jesus into your life without promising to read the Bible."* She said, *"ok."*

Then Brittany prayed out loud, asking Jesus to come into her life. As soon as she was done praying, her next statement was, *"We have an hour before dinner. I'm going to go to the church next door and read the Bible for a while."*

You just never know.

A few weeks later, her best friend, Kayla, said to me, *"I think it's great what's happened to Brittany. But this isn't for me."*

I asked her, *"You and Brittany are best friends. Do you think God would want a relationship with her, and not with you?"* Kayla also became a Christian.

Maybe you have never had someone directly ask you how they can become a Christian.

But they might say, *"I really need to change my life."* Or, *"I'd like to find God."* Or, *"I wish my life was different."*

At that point, I often will ask people, *"Has anyone ever told you how you can have a relationship with God?"*

Note how I asked that question. I'm not blaming them for not knowing. I'm suggesting that someone else simply never told them.

"Has anyone ever told you how you can have a relationship with God?"

On your mobile device, you can simply take them to EveryStudent.com, to this article, [How to Know God Personally](#).

(You can always find this article by typing into the site's search box: Know God
It's also the first article in the menu section "Finding God.")

Holding your mobile device, ask if you could just read it with them. If they say yes, literally read it out loud to them.

If that does not seem appropriate, ask if you could message them a link to it.

How to Talk about God - Offer Donuts!

Hi,

We've covered a LOT of ground so far. How are you doing? Have you been able to try a couple of things?

Today's email is easy and fun. Won't require much mental work. Whew.

This will give you a way to help bring the gospel to your friends on Facebook or any social media platform, but in somewhat of a passive way.

First, I've got to share with you a wacky illustration from a friend of mine. You will never forget this.

Brace yourself.

My friend said, "You need to realize that when we are talking to people about Jesus, we are talking to people who are spiritually 'dead.'"

Ephesians 2:1 says, "As for you, you were dead in your transgressions and sins, in which you used to live when you followed the ways of this world..."

Ephesians 2:4 continues... "But because of his great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, made us alive with Christ..."

So, we are talking with people who are spiritually dead, and only God can make them come alive.

My friend said...

"It's like us walking into a morgue, with dead bodies lying there. And we come in with Dunkin' Donuts. And we lay a Dunkin' Donut next to each head of each corpse." (gross, I know)

Can we make them come alive and eat that donut? No.

Only God can make them come alive. He is the one who opens their eyes, speaks to their hearts, and draws them to himself.

Our job? "Offer some donuts."

Today, I'm going to show you how you can do this using EveryStudent.com.

Here's how you can offer an article or video from EveryStudent.com, on your favorite social network site.

In Facebook, when you copy and paste in the page URL, the title of the article will appear, along with a photo from the article and a brief description. That means you can also say something or you don't have to.

Whether it is an article or video (doesn't matter), just copy the URL address at the top of the page and paste that URL into your social media, or a text message, or email.

How to Talk about God - In Social Media

Hi,

My favorite verse: Philemon verse 6 (rsv)

"And I pray that the sharing of your faith may promote the knowledge of all the good that is ours in Christ Jesus our Lord."

How's that for a great assignment? As you share your faith, you help people know all the good that is ours in Christ Jesus our Lord.

In Matthew 13, Jesus tells the parable of the farmer who sowed some seed broadly. He just threw it out there. He didn't make sure it landed only on the good soil. It was ok with him if some landed on rocks. Or dry ground. Or in a pile of thorns. His job was to sow the seed.

In the same way, we don't really know what's in a person's heart.

When I was an atheist, I didn't appear interested in God. But I was. And I'm glad my friend was willing to keep talking to me about God, even on those days when I seemed hard as rock.

The following gives you a way to sow the gospel broadly. We throw it out there. And let God use it as he will.

Today, I'm going to give you a list of some articles and videos that are on EveryStudent.com. You could pick one a week, and share it in your Facebook status box, or on Twitter, Reddit, etc. The wide variety of topics gives you an easy way to sow broadly.

How to Talk about God - Help Nonbelievers More

Hi,

Here's an interesting prayer request that was sent to me. It's from a Christian on a campus. She was sharing the gospel with someone, and here was the result.

She writes...

--- I went through the Knowing God Personally booklet [a gospel tract] with a student named Cori. We spent about 45 minutes discussing and clarifying the gospel. Cori said this was the best news she had heard and felt that her heart was ready to accept Jesus. "But, if I accept Jesus, that means that I am not Buddhist anymore." So she is still deciding. Pray for Cori! ---

What is missing here? This Christian went through the gospel. Even spent 45 minutes answering her questions and clarifying the issues.

Cori thought it sounded great. But she was hesitant.

"Pray for Cori" is absolutely right to do. And this Christian did a great job.

But what else? What could this Christian have done for Cori?

She could have served her further, by saying:

"Cori, I understand that this is an important decision. There is a great site that you can go to, that will be very helpful to you. EveryStudent.com. It answers questions about Jesus, about what it's like to know him.

I'm going to write the URL on the back of this booklet for you. You'll find it very encouraging. And, here's my email address also. [or phone #]. Could I have yours also? Would it be ok with you if I contact you in a few days, after you've had a chance to look at the site?"

At the end of a conversation, we can serve unbelievers more, by letting them explore their questions further. Let them hear more. Let God lead them to answers to the questions in their heart.

It might help them make the decision you are praying for!

How to Talk about God - With Atheists

Hi,

How can you help atheists?

In Asia and India, atheists might be described as people who do not believe in the existence of one supreme God, creator of all.

In Western Europe, atheists will likely appear totally apathetic about God.

In the U.S., many atheists are clearly on the offensive. They get a real kick out of being demeaning. It's nearly become a competitive sport. "Read my blog today...see what I did to those stupid Christians."

But, there is a lot going on in their hearts and minds that they are not telling you...

I remember debating my Christian friend when I was an atheist. She didn't know this. But after winning the argument, I'd walk away thinking,

"She believes everything she was saying. And I'm not sure that I believe anything I just said. I just wanted to win the argument."

Christians have a real edge -- authenticity.

Now, to be fair, many atheists actually want to believe in God, if they had good reasons to do so. They just don't want to be fooled into believing something that's not true.

So how do we share Christ with an atheist? Matthew 10:16 is very fitting. Jesus said, "I am sending you out as sheep in the midst of wolves, so be wise as serpents and innocent as doves."

Be innocent. (Be loving and respectful.) And also be wise as serpents. Some versions say be "shrewd."

Here's the challenge. Who has time to become proficient in atheistic debate? Do you? Do you have time to research and grapple with the kinds of questions atheists love to throw at Christians? ie.

Can you prove God exists?

How do you explain the droughts, food shortages, violent weather, earthquakes?

How do you explain why God would allow a child to be raped?

Don't you realize the Bible is just created out of a human agenda?

If you had just 5 or 10 minutes to reply, what could you possibly say that would sound convincing? These, and many other questions are addressed on EveryStudent.com. Example:

[Is There a God?](#), [Does God Answer Prayer?](#), [Where Is God in the Midst of Tragedy?](#), [Why Worship a God Who Allows Suffering?](#), etc.

EveryStudent.com is written directly to the unbeliever. It doesn't just give facts and information. While answering these questions, we also seek to persuade a person to start a relationship with God.

So, when you're in a conversation with an atheist, you might encourage them to see EveryStudent.com.

You could simply say, "I know a great site created by a former atheist. It presents evidence in a respectful way. And the site has no ads and doesn't ask for money. Kind of nice. May I give you a card to it?" (cards available [here](#))

Here's an *important* benefit to pointing them to the site.

When I was an atheist, I was very much on guard in my conversations with my friend. I was focused on defending my atheism. Rebuttals. Anything that would make me feel quite secure in discounting God.

However, one day my friend gave me a book. Away from her my defenses could come down. I could be honest.

And that's when God really spoke to me. That's when I realized how strong the evidence was for God's existence.

You could give the person the same respect. The same freedom.

If they seem very interested, then you might encourage your friend to sign up for "[The Spiritual Adventure Pack](#)."

It is a 7-email series, specifically written for atheists and those who wonder about God. Many atheists are moved by it. Like Carolyn, from the UK:

“ ...by reading the information you provided I have been able to find answers to many of my questions. You have led me from complete denial of God's existence to not just believing in Him but knowing that He is there. The evidence you give was sufficient to convince this 33 year old, life-long atheist - not an easy challenge!”

When you're with the person, go to EveryStudent.com. Then scroll down the home page to find the Spiritual Adventure Pack, a square drawing of a hiker with a backpack and walking stick.

Show the person the icon, then click on it and hand your phone to the person to sign up with their email address. Tell them they will only receive those 7 emails, and they'll be an unsubscribe link at the end of each email if they want to unsubscribe.

Atheists love to play stump-the-Christian. You now have something helpful for them. You have messages written, produced just for them, that will challenge them. And it will be an opportunity for God to speak to them and draw them to himself.

How to Talk about God - At Events

Hi,

Has your church or organization ever hosted an evangelistic event? Maybe it's a special speaker? Or concert, film?

It is a lot of work organizing these, isn't it?

You have to get the right sound system in place, lighting, the right staging, seating. You also have to promote the event, encourage people to tell their friends...

You devote a lot of time (and money) to this. And hopefully, it is well worth it.

So now, picture your speaker finishing his or her message. Or the concert is coming to a close. The evening is almost over. Some people in your audience still have important, unanswered questions.

Maybe new questions that came to mind.

Or lingering questions they have always had about God, that they wished someone would answer! There might be just one question that is holding them back from receiving Christ.

And, at this moment, God has their attention.

After they leave, it is easy to move on. Easy to get caught up in other aspects of life, friends, responsibilities, deadlines. Those questions can lose their importance.

So here's what you do. At the very end, have the speaker say:

"You might have questions about God that you still need answered. If so, we'd like to recommend a great website you can go to, EveryStudent.com." (Ideally, put the name "EveryStudent.com" up on the screen.)

The speaker continues, "And if you asked Jesus into your lives tonight, there's a website that can help you grow to know God better, called StartingwithGod.com." (Have that also come up on the screen.)

People will be pulling out their phones and typing those in. Then have the speaker end with, "On your way out, someone will hand you a card with both of these sites on it. I'd like everyone to take a card, even if it is so you can pass it along to someone else."

You might want to add your church or organization contact information on the back of the card. (If not, already printed cards are available [here](#).)

Imagine the number of people who might come to Christ by simply adding that 30 second announcement to your event. Many will take you up on your offer that evening, and be very thankful for knowing where to turn for answers right away.

To more powerful speaking events!

How to Talk about God - New Believers

Hi,

What happens when your church or organization or YOU lead people to Christ? How do you make sure those new believers grow?

Often the approach is to ask if they will meet with you a few days later. Or maybe invite them to a Bible study. If you're good friends, they might come.

But if you're not good friends, if you hardly know the person, then what? When they are invited, typically few of those you invited show up, less than one-third, I'm told. Sometimes fewer than that.

That's a problem. We would never be content with feeding only a third of newborns in a nursery.

Yet these people aren't in a nursery. If they received Christ in a church or evangelistic outreach, they are scattered everywhere, going about their busy lives. How can we help them grow?

There's a way to help every new believer begin growing right away. Hours or minutes after they ask Jesus into their lives. And it's free to them and to you.

You simply say, "Right now, pull out your phone and let's go to StartingwithGod.com. I'd like you to sign up for the free email series, *The Spiritual Starter Kit*. It will help you begin to grow in your new relationship with God."

One time, I shared the gospel with a good friend in Starbucks and she asked Jesus into her life. I didn't live in her city and was flying home that evening.

I asked her if she knew any Christians. And it turns out she had a friend who went to a great church. So I said, "Today, ask to have lunch with your friend tomorrow. Tell her you received Christ, and ask her to sign up for this, so you can go through it together."

That's exactly what she did. She told me later how helpful that series was for both her and her friend.

Here's another true story...I was in an airport in another country and a woman started talking with me. She asked about my travels and I said, "I'm connected to a site that takes on the hard questions about life and God. It's from a Christian perspective."

She said, "WAIT!" And she reached into her briefcase and pulled out this enormous Bible. (I thought, "Who travels internationally with a book that big?") She said, "I'm a recovering alcoholic. I became a Christian and I just bought this, but I have no idea what to do with it."

I helped her sign up for The Spiritual Starter Kit, thrilled that I could help her so well. I'm convinced, when you can help people, God just brings people your way!

Wouldn't it be great to help a new believer immediately understand their new relationship with God? That they are forgiven. They are now at peace with God. A child of God. No longer living in darkness. They now have eternal life. And the Holy Spirit lives in them.
